

Summary of Local Ordinances for Parking on the Grass

Location	Code	Requirement
City of Temple	Code of Ordinances, Article IV, Section 4.2	Conditions Constituting a Nuisance. The following specific acts, conditions, items, and things are declared a nuisance and are unlawful; provided, however, that this list shall not be deemed or construed to be conclusive, limiting or restrictive: (16) Parking, or allowing others to park vehicles in the yard, grass, or on any other unimproved parking surface or portion or property, unless screened from public view in compliance with the Unified Development Code.
City of Killeen	Code of Ordinances, Article V, Section 28-135	Except as provided in this section, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on anything other than an all-weather surface. An all-weather surface shall consist of cement, concrete or an impervious bituminous surface over a compacted base or other surface approved by the building official. The parking surface for property zoned or used for commercial and multifamily use must be capable of retaining paint or striping material.
City of Nolanville	Code of Ordinances, Division 6, Section 560.1	Whenever a structure is erected, converted, or structurally altered for a single-family dwelling, a minimum of 2 parking space[s] shall be provided and maintained on the lot for the building. Such parking spaces shall be arranged on the lot so as to permit satisfactory ingress and egress of an automobile and such parking space shall be in addition to driveway and shall be surfaced and maintained with an all-weather surface such as asphalt, concrete or other similar permanent hard surface material sufficient to prevent mud, dust, loose material, and other nuisances. Parking in the yard is prohibited.
City of Georgetown	Code of Ordinances, Chapter 10, Section 10.16.070	A. No person shall stop, stand or park or allow any vehicle to be stopped or parked in the front or side yard of private property used for residential purposes, except as provided herein. All vehicles shall be parked on a(n): 1. Driveway; 2. Existing gravel driveway-for property used for residential purposes on or before the effective date of this Section; or 3. Approved surface. B. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to allow, permit or suffer any vehicle to stop, stand or park in the front or side yard in the public right-of-way in a manner which interferes with the public use of the right-of-way.
City of Farmers Branch	Code of Ordinances, Division 2, Section 56-141	Parking or the storage of any vehicle upon any surface other than an improved parking surface shall be prohibited. This subsection shall apply to all land, properties and/or premises located in the city, including public rights-of-way.
City of Portland (Texas)	Code of Ordinances, Chapter 21, Article VI, Section 21-80	Regulations. (1) Parking on unimproved surfaces restricted. A person commits an offense if, upon a residential single-family, duplex or townhouse lot or tract: a. The person causes, permits or allows the parking or storage of any vehicle in the front yard upon any surface other than an improved parking surface.
